EuroTrak




- Initiated by EHIMA in 2009
- Questionnaire designed to be compatible with U.S. MarkeTrak to secure crecontinent comparisons

NEW

- On-line survey method
 - Surveys mailed to online panel members. Samples balanced, based on census information with respect to age, gender and region
- Focus on hearing status and hearing aid usage
 - Self assessment
- Issued in parallel in England, Germany and France (+Italy & Spain for ET IV)
- Repeated every 3 years to generate trends over time



% hearing loss prevalence








Hearing aid adoption increases

HL sixtiles: how is degree of hearing loss defined?



- Self-reported !!
- A factor analysis was performed to identify one factor "degree of hearing loss"
- The following questions were included in the factor:

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
- Number of ears impaired (one or two)
- Stated hearing loss (Mild, Moderate, Severe, Profound)
- Scores on 6 APHAB-EC like questions (Scaled 1-5)*
- When NOT using a hearing aid, how difficult is it for you to follow conversations in the presence of noise
- People were segmented into 6 groups of same size (16.67% of all hearing impaired in the sample)











Image of hearing aids is improving



Reasons for not having a HA (top 50% HL)






Satisfaction with HA features and performance increased




Satisfaction with HA in difficult listening situations is improving






Binaural fitting rate increased from 2009 to 2015






Binaurally fitted use their hearing aids more





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


The opinion of hearing impaired people on what could be linked to one's hearing loss



Please tick all of the health issues below which you think could be linked to one's hearing loss

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


Positive impact of HA's on physical stress




Positive impact of HA's on mental stress




People with hearing aids sleep better




The positive impact of HA's on depressive symptoms



How useful are your hearing aids on your job?

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




Employed HA users more often earn a higher salary

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




Hearing impaired non-users declare more often to receive a worse salary than their peers






82% of all users do not feel they're made fun of. Non-users often feel made fun of (41%)

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


Vast majority declare that their hearing aids improve their quality of life



How often do your hearing aids improve your quality of life?

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


82% of the hearing aid owners say their hearing aid works better than or as expected

- hearing aids work worse than I expected














3 out of 4 hearing aid owners feel more confident moving in a city since wearing hearing aids



Since wearing a hearing aid, do you feel more confident moving in a city, e.g. because you hear traffic signals/vehicles approaching?


















Also for other people in the household/relatives, the situation improves when the person with hearing loss starts wearing hearing aids
